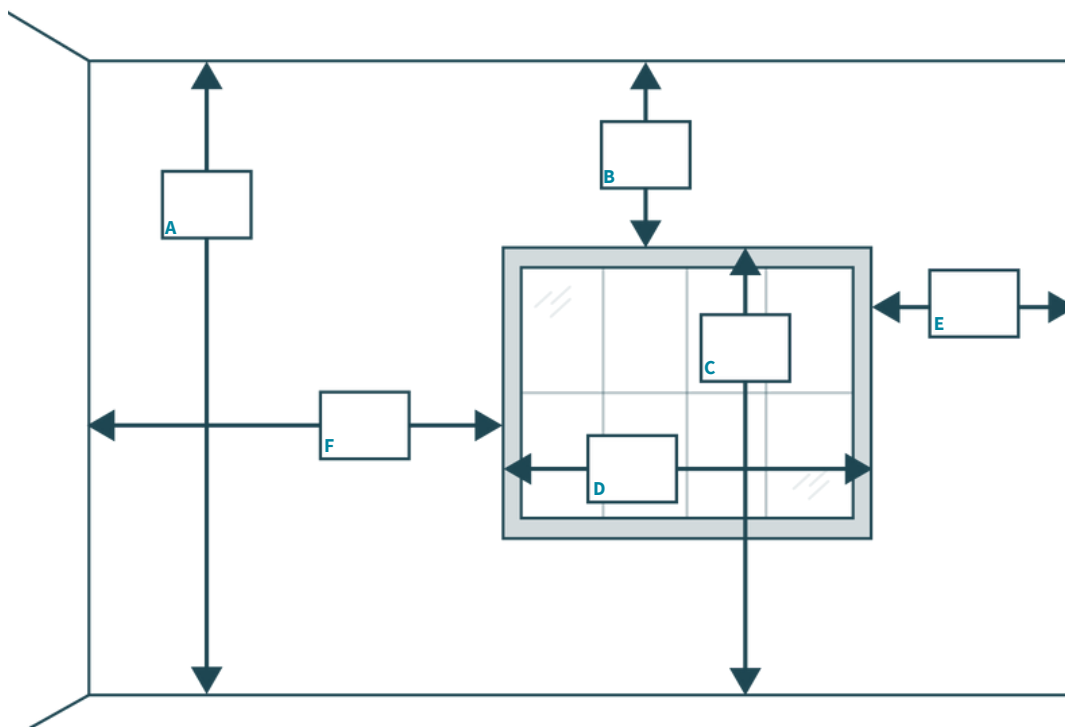

- E** On the right side, the distance from the window to the nearest wall/art/obstruction
- F** On the left side, the distance from the window to the nearest wall/art/obstruction
